



Shanghai exempts quarantine measures for passengers from Japan

Shanghai Municipal Government announced on March 22, 2020, from March 23, 2020, **passengers who have lived or travelled in Japan** within the 14 days before their arrival in Shanghai doesn't have to undergo a 14-day quarantine at home or in designated places.

In addition to **South Korea, Italy, Iran, France, Spain, Germany, the United States, Britain, Switzerland, Sweden, Belgium, Norway, the Netherlands, Denmark, Austria, Australia, Malaysia, Greece, Czech Republic, Finland, Qatar, Canada, and Saudi Arabia**, people who have lived or travelled in **Philippines** within the 14 days before their arrival in Shanghai, must undergo a 14-day quarantine at home or in designated places.

Highlights: Shanghai Municipal Government regulated that **all inbound passengers in Shanghai will receive nucleic acid test**. Therefore, passengers who have lived or travelled in Japan will receive nucleic acid test. If the result of test is negative, passengers can go home. **(Although Shanghai Municipal Government didn't regulate quarantine measures on these passengers, whether they need to undergo a 14-day quarantine at home is decided by the community they lived in because of its self-management.)** If the result of test is positive, passengers will be transferred to the designated medical institutions.
