### 1. The National Policies

Department	Time	Overview of Policy
1.1 The State Council	3/17/2020 Guidelines for wearing masks	The Guidelines gave proposes for wearing masks in different scenarios and classified people into four categories: the general public, people in special areas, key persons and staff easily exposed to COVID-19.
1.2 The State Council	3/18/2020 The measures for stabilizing the employment under COVID-19	The measures proposed twenty-two opinions involving in six aspects, including cancelling the unreasonable approval for resumption; increasing the returning of the unemployment insurance, for small, medium-sized and micro enterprises without layoffs, the returning of the unemployment insurance can be increased to the total amount of last year's unemployment insurance.
1.3 General Administration of Customs	3/19/2020 The lists of measures for border prevention and the convenience for customs clearance	The lists required that customs inspection without the owner's being present, the disinfectant cosmetics can be added the label after entering, the green channels are set up for agricultural products and food.

2.1 Beijing	3/16/2020 Measures for epidemic prevention and supporting the enterprises' resumption of work and production in an organized way	Ten measures are issued to support the enterprises' resumption of work and production in an organized way, including supervising the enterprises' measures for epidemic prevention, assisting enterprises' purchasing the preventing materials, strengthening the logistics and traffic.

Area	Time	Overview of Policy
3.1 Shanghai	3/16/2020 Notice: adjusting the record of enterprises' resumption of work	Except for special situations, enterprises and individual businesses can resume working without the record in Shanghai.

### 4. Policies in Jiangsu

Area	Time	Overview of Policy
4.1 Suzhou City	3/19/2020 Notice: speeding up the resumption of work and production in Suzhou City	The Notice required that: 1) Service industries can resume working without the record; 2) Catering industries can choose to resume working at its discretion; 3) Part of the cultural tourism and entertainment industries can resume working without the record. Part of them can resume working after receiving the notice from the relevant department; 4) Stadiums can resume working after implementing the measures for epidemic prevention.

### 5. Policies in Zhejiang



Area	Time	Overview of Policy
5.1 Zhejiang Province	3/17/2020 Notice: implementing the policies of land use tax and real estate tax to mitigate the impact of COVID-19	In addition to the micro-sized enterprises, enterprises from the industries of accommodation and catering, entertainment, transportation, and tourism would be exempted from the land use tax and real estate tax for three months. The Notice also encouraged the owners of business property to reduce the rental fees for enterprises in difficulties.
5.2 Hangzhou City	3/21/2020 Notice: adjusting the measures for epidemic prevention	The Notice required: 1) Epidemic measures for the inbound person; 2) Canceling the health code and temperature screening in the public and transportation; 3) The situations for not wearing the masks; 4) The places can be open for the public.

## 6. Policies in Sichuan

Area	Time	Overview of Policy
6.1 Sichuan	3/18/2020 Notice: Establishment of mutual recognition of health code based on the platform of national governmental service	The Notice required: 1) People holding the local health code, national health code or health certificate from ten provinces or cities with the mutual recognition of Sichuan shall not undergo 14-day quarantine; 2) Other people holding the national health code of the platform of national government service shall not undergo a 14-day quarantine.

## 7. Policies in Shandong

Area	Time	Overview of Policy
7.1 Shandong	3/21/2020 Shandong has made mutual	Up to March 20, Shandong's health code can be recognized in Sichuan, Xinjiang, Jiangsu,



	recognition of health code with thirteen provinces	Guangdong, Shanghai, Hainan, Zhejiang, Jilin, Anhui, Inner Mongolia, Fujian, Hainan, and Qinghai. People who are not from the above places shall undergo a 14-day quarantine if they come to Shandong.
7.2 Shandong	3/21/2020 Inbound people shall report the schedule in advance	Before three days of inbound people's arrival, family members or relatives shall report inbound people's arriving date, flight number, travel history, health condition, passport and contact information to the community he will live in.
